

Bulbs come in all types, shapes, colours and sizes and are renowned for their beautiful blooms appearing in late winter through to spring. Most like to be planted in full sun or semi-shade. The general guide for planting is to plant the bulbs twice as deep as they are tall. e.g. If the bulb is 5cm in height, it should be planted at a depth of 10cm.
